1. Forwarded herewith, in one original and one photocopy, is CIC report L/24372, dated 27 December 1951. Subject: Location of Certain Persons. This report contains a certain amount of information on Monsignore Jozsef ZAGON.

2. It will be remembered that ZAGON's name has come up in [] reports, which makes him of some interest. We have recently received USAGE report numbered X-33, dated 19 December 1951, on ZAGON which contains a certain amount of background information on him. We assume that this USAGE report is available to Headquarters. We are particularly interested to note in the USAGE report that ZAGON is closely connected with (Professor) Janos STOMFAY-STITZ of French intelligence, and also with (Prelate) Antal LEPOID of the Vienna Pazmaneum.

3. [] has informed us that, according to [] ZAGON is merely one of the many Catholic Church connections with USAGE, who functions only as a spotter of agents or persons with valuable information. However, any approach to ZAGON on intelligence matters would undoubtedly be reported to USAGE, even on a recommendation from Graceful. [] also indicated that G-2 files contain no information on Zagon.

Disposition Form from G-2, USFA, to Commanding Officer, 430th CIC Detachment, dated 29 October 1951, Subject: Location of Certain Persons, Opns. File No. 3054, requesting information on individuals mentioned in basic communication.

RESULTS OF INVESTIGATION:

1. On 16 November 1951, Kalman DABOLCI-FEKETE, Lager 106, Enns, Upper Austria, unemployed displaced person, who has an extensive knowledge of displaced persons in Austria due to his long occupancy of DP Camps, and who acts as a frequent informant of the Enns Field Office, this Sub-Detachment, furnished the following information concerning Dr. Jozsef ZAGON. Source had been in mail correspondence with ZAGON, who is the apostolical visitor of the Hungarians living in exile, in June 1951. Source related that although ZAGON travels extensively throughout Austria, Germany, and Italy, SUBJECT presently has an office and lives at Mutters, Tyrol Land, Austria, near Innsbruck. Source gave SUBJECT's mail address there as Innsbruck 2, Postfach 507. Source also related that ZAGON maintains an address where he might be contacted as follows: Dr. Jozsef ZAGON, Visitator Apostolicus Extra Ordinem Pro Profugis Hungaris, Via Della Conciliazione 44, Rome, Italy. 2. On 16 November 1951, Dr. (no first name) CSEJELY, prominent DP Hungarian personality residing at Barrack 17/9, Lager Asten, Camp 117, Upper Austria, was discreetly interviewed and furnished the following information: Source was previously acquainted with Matthias VESZY, who was once a deputy of the Hungarian Commoner Party and is now a refugee. Source stated that he had seen an article published in the "HUNGARIA" (Weekly Hungarian Refugee Newspaper, published at Bad Woerishofen, Bavaria, Germany, by Dr. Janos MAKRA, publisher, with the assistance of IRO), which listed SUBJECT as immigrating to the United States about August-September 1951. Source related that SUBJECT is a member of the Hungarian Organization in New York City, which is headed by former Hungarian Minister President Ferenc NAGY, fru SULLYOK, and Bella VARGA. Source suggested SUBJECT might be located through this organization. (F-3)

Bezirk Voecklabruck, Upper Austria, disclosed that one Josef ~~SWEIN~~, born on 16 October 1897 in Keglwichshausen, Rumania, laborer, has been residing at the Gammingerstrasse Electric Plant, Attnang-Puchheim, Upper Austria, since 31 December 1949. (B-2)

4. On 30 November 1951, the files of the Gemeindegemeinschaft Mondsee, Upper Austria, revealed that a Moritz ~~SZECHENYI~~, born on 10 July 1902 in Rum, Hungary, resided at No. 178, Mondsee, Upper Austria, from 11 June 1949 until the end of August 1950, when he emigrated to England. (B-2)
