<p>1. According to a fairly reliable KUBARK source, Raksanyi is the son of a Hungarian landowner. He received a good education, and shortly after obtaining his law degree in 1943, he was named secretary to the President of the Hungarian Senate. In 1945 he became secretary to the President of the House of Parliament, Mag. Bela Varga. The source characterized him as a loyal man of medium talent but capable of development.</p> <p>.....5. Another unconfirmed report indicates that Raksanyi was working closely with General Andras Zako in 1948. Although there is no proof, this activity may have been undertaken on behalf of the French.</p>
