1. General Andreas ZAKO is conducting a campaign to obtain American support of his group through Hungarian refugees now in the United States. The latest plea from ZAKO for American support came through one LASSLO AGH. AGH has previously approached Headquarters on ZAKO's behalf and one JOHN S. JUBASZ has also presented a request for support of the same group. The attached letter was written by ZAKO to AGH. You will note the reference to the CODEUM Hungarian operations.

2. We would be interested in knowing whether the French are withdrawing their support of ZAKO or if there is a split in the ranks of the group. It appears to us that ZAKO wants to enlist American support primarily for financial reasons and probably maintain his FIS connections at the same time.

3. The attached letter did not come through the same channels as the Ferenc TARNADI-WACAS plan, forwarded to you with MAY-N-2024. We believe that the two are connected in a concerted effort of this Hungarian emigre group to gain American help. However, we would appreciate your comments. No action is contemplated regarding the attached at Headquarters.
