The two Germans were DOLLMANN and ZIMMER. DOLLMANN, PARILI insisted to DBOOL privately, was representing KESSELRING, RAHN, WOLF and HARSTER. He himself never so stated however. ^{A Standartenführer in the SS} He is HILBER's Italian interpreter and is active at present as the Führer's liaison officer at KESSELRING's headquarters. He is the one given credit for saving Rome from destruction. He is about 45, intellectual, refined and has a Foreign Office manner. ZIMMER, his companion, is younger. There is something hard in his manner that indicates a possible Police background.

DBOOL arrived at Lugano at 3 p.m. ...

The meeting was held in a private dining room of the restaurant Biaggi, at Lugano. Present: DOLLMANN, ZIMMER, PARILI, Dr. HUSMANN, Lt. ROTBLITZ and DBOOL. The conversation was mostly in French, which DOLLMANN speaks fairly and understands well. He was careful to have every important statement translated into German for ZIMMER's benefit, in a way that seemed to indicate that the latter was present as an observer."
