<p>PERTINENT INFORMATION</p> <p>Through Lt. Col. LADA-MOCARSKI, Mr. JOYCE met in Rome Mr. <u>Zsolt ARADI</u>, now in Bari under the name of <u>Michael MOLNAR</u>. His code name will be "<u>Slats</u>", "Slats" is a Hungarian Catholic of partially Jewish descent, from a large landowner family. He is 36 years old, married, with three children, the family now living in Rome. A journalist and writer by profession, he has been active in the Hungarian Boy Scouts and Catholic Welfare agencies. Through Baron APCOR, he was appointed press attache at the Hungarian Consulate, Milan, in June 1941; in June 1943, he undertook the same duties with Baron APCOR in Rome. After the German occupation of Hungary, he refused allegiance to the new regime, took refuge in the Vatican, and offered his services to the Allies on the liberation of Rome. He is an exceedingly intelligent man, politically well-versed, and possessing excellent contacts, both open and clandestine. After a thorough security check, we plan to use him in Hungarian SI.
