Enclosed is a letter received from Budapest via Mr. Merrill. In transmitting the letter, Mr. Merrill also sent the signed receipts for the payments to Moly's contacts and stated that he had delivered all of the sums enclosed in our recent letter to him.

He also stated that it would be impossible for him to continue to deliver mail, packages and other communications for us to people in Budapest. The transmission of this material has reached the attention of other officials in the office who have stated that it is irregular and must be discontinued. Under the circumstances I have to return to you the stockings, magazine, and letter which Ander wished to send and to ask you not to transmit to me any further letters for people in Hungary through Mr. Merrill. Mr. Merrill states that regular mail communication with Hungary should be open sometime toward the end of this month.
