I attached a copy of a letter sent to Lt. Col. Howard M. Chapin. I would very appreciate if you could read it. This is my final statement but not a testimony...

I had several contacts with my Padre Gehrmann, and in the next days some important information will follow. He must be undertake everything possible to get the permit to Berlin, and I think we should pave his way. Gehrmann is certainly ready to collaborate. Col. Thayer when in Salzburg asked me about the Gehrmann's status and other questions and told me that after his return from Switzerland wanted to talk me about all that.

Anything else I wanted to let you know is in the letter to Col. Chapin.

Is there any possibility to go to Vienna for some days or to have some contacts which I think nobody touched yet.
