Reference A requests that a temporary waiver of the Security and Reliability Determination be made in connection with Subject who is Chief of the Intelligence Operations Staff (I A Fuehrung) of the Collection Division (Department I) of the West German Intelligence Service (BND), and deputy to the Collection Division chief. He will be visiting Headquarters Building 27 - 29 November 1972 for discussions and briefings.

2. In view of C/E/G/CIL's comments in his memo of 10 November concerning the restriction of Subject's access to sensitive information, we have concurred in your request for a waiver. Please complete the checks previously requested by us so we may eventually issue a full SRD. In accordance with discussions concerning this case, you should also continue to conduct periodic checks on Subject in an effort to resolve unfavorable elements in his security background.

3. Pursuant to authority granted in CSI No. 60-10, a waiver is hereby issued for Subject pending completion of the additional traces which are necessary for a security determination.
