DURING 21 SEP 83 MEETING AT CASCOPE DEPT I CHIEF ALBRECHT RAUSCH'S OFFICE, [ ] SUGGESTED THAT FOLLOWING 22 SEP PLANNED INTRODUCTION SESSION BETWEEN [ ] AND CASCOPE PRESIDENT, IT WOULD BE PROPITIOUS FOR ALIAS ACKERMANN TO SET UP CONCRETE AGENDA FOR FOLLOW-UP "JOIN OPS IN BERLIN" DISCUSSION. RAUSCH NOTED THAT A WHILE AGO, AL [ ] /CASCOPE VICE PRESIDENT DISCUSSION ON POSSIBLE TARGETS IN BONN AREA FOR JOINT OPS EXPLOITATION HAD RESULTED IN GENERAL AGREEMENT THAT IDEA HAD MERIT, WHICH CASCOPE VP HAD FOLLOWED UP WITH LETTER TO [ ] REACTION TO WHICH NOT YET RECEIVED. RAUSCH ALSO SEEMED TO FEEL THAT ACKERMANN PROBABLY BEING OVERLY OPTIMISTIC ON OPS POSSIBILITIES IN BERLIN.

2. IN VIEW REF A BERLIN MEETING WHICH WAS IMMINENT AND FACT RAUSCH WAS SUBSEQUENTLY GOING ON TEN DAYS VACATION, WHICH WOULD LEAVE ALIAS ACKERMANN AS ACTING DEPT I CHIEF, WE DECIDED MOST EXPEDITIOUS WAY TO GET ON WITH MATTER WOULD BE TO AWAIT RESULTS BERLIN MEETING AND DECIDE NEXT STEP.

3. IN VIEW REF A, WITH ADDEE CONCURRENCE, [ ] WILL NOW RECONTACT ACKERMANN, CONFIRM OUR WILLINGNESS TO PROCEED AS SUGGESTED REF A PARA 4 AND ASK FROM OR SUGGEST TO ACKERMANN A MUTUALLY CONVENIENT CONFERENCE DATE. PLS ADVISE.
