At the request of [] the TILSTONIANS have continually asked the TIEBARS for increased support. Apparently at long last the constant demands and expressions of dissatisfaction with the limited TIEBAR support have had some effect. [] has advised [] that [] TIRRALIRRA and General. TEPFERS (not naming them) have asked for the equivalent of one million Sw. kr. for supporting the resistance movements in each of the three countries concerned.

...The TIEBAR problem, over which we presume [] and [] have spent long hours, is basically, shall they keep control of a "shoestring" but basically desirable project or let us in on one which they feel might eventually get too large for them. [] will confer with [] and [] individually and collectively and go over each point with each person and then they will compare notes. We insist on memorandums for the record purposes which lessens the possibility of misunderstanding...
