SUBJECT: Questions for []

1. Can [] identify any of the following as KGB agents or known to be of interest to the KGB:

a. Vytautas STANEVICIUS, who used the aliases Vytautas STANEIKA, STANIS, Major STUGGA, MESKIS, a Lithuanian resistance leader who went with Jonas DEKSNYS from West Germany via Poland to Soviet Lithuania and returned with his wife and DEKSNYS via Danzig to Sweden in 1946. He presently resides in the USA.

b. Jurgis VALIULIS alias Darolis DRUNGA, or Karolis DRUNGA, a Lithuanian resistance member, who was in contact with DEKSNYS in Lithuania and exfiltrated to the West via Poland in 1946.

c. Stacys ZAKEVICIUS alias Stacys ZYMANAS, PAULIUS, PAUL, BUTAUTAS, a Lithuanian resistance leader in Sweden in 1940s, where he was in close contact with Algirdas VOKIETAITIS and Jonas DEKSNYS. He reportedly arrived in Poland illegally from Sweden in 1948, where he met DEKSNYS. He presently resides in USA.

d. Vladas ZILINSKAS, a Lithuanian resistance member in Sweden in the 1940s.

e. Hans Helmut KLOSE, a former German Navy Captain who ran boat operations to Poland and the Baltic States for the British in the late 1940s and early 1950s.

f. Anton OLEKA, the alias of a Lithuanian national who resided in Danzig area and escaped to Sweden in 1946.

g. Wilhelm STRAND, a Swedish sailor who tried to take a Lithuanian refugee from Danzig to Sweden on a 700-ton ship in 1945. However, the captain of this ship did not permit STRAND to go through with his plans.

h. Janis VASARAJIS, born circa 1910 in Latvia. He escaped from Gdynia to Sweden by ship in 1947.

i. ROZENBLATAS, a Lithuanian national and friend of VOKIETAITIS in Sweden in the 1940s.

j. Colonel Jozas NARAKAS, a Lithuania national who was imprisoned in a Nazi KZ camp near Danzig. Somehow, he escaped from Poland after World War II and now lives in Sweden.

k. Jonas BARTKUS, an alias of a Lithuanian national, who resided under that name near Danzig after World War II. He escaped by boat to Sweden in 1946.

l. Father Stecys YLA, a Lithuanian national, who was imprisoned together with VOKIETAITIS in a Nazi KZ camp near Danzig. Somehow, he managed to get out of Poland after the war and now resides near Putnam, Conn., USA.

m. Vincas MICKUS, a Lithuanian national, who lived on a farm near the village of Grudno in Danzig area after World War II. During the winter of 1945/46 VOKIETAITIS lived at Subject's farm. Since MICKUS was a former US citizen, he was permitted to emigrate from Poland to the USA. Now lives in Philadelphia.

n. Algirdas LAUZIKAS, a Lithuanian national who lived together with VOKIETAITIS at Vincas MICKUS' farm near Grudno. He was a student from Vilnius, and later repatriated to Soviet Lithuania. LAUZIKAS provided VOKIETAITIS with Polish documents in alias with residence in Raciborz, Poland.

o. PETKUS family also lived on MICKUS farm. Later on they repatriated to Soviet Lithuania.

p. Balys SROUGA, a Lithuanian national, who was imprisoned in a Nazi camp near Danzig, where he was in contact with VOKIETAITIS. Later on SROUGA repatriated to Soviet Lithuania.

q. UPITIS, a Latvian national and 1st Lt. in the Latvian Legion during World War II. He organized 1) legal escapes from Gdynia to Sweden in late 1940s. Now resides in Sweden.

r. Antanas STARKUS, a Lithuanian Medical Doctor, who was imprisoned in a Nazi KZ camp near Danzig, where he was in contact with VOKIETAITIS. He reportedly escaped from Poland to Sweden after World War II.

s. ZANDERSONS, a Latvian who participated in organizing illegal escapes with UPTITIS from Gdynia to Sweden in late 1940s.

t. Mrs. KUJAKS, a Latvian and mistress of Janis VASARAJS. She escaped by boat from Gdynia to Sweden in late 1940s.

u. MAZUR, a Polish farmer, who had three daughters and one 4 year old child in 1945. VOKIETAITIS lived on MAZUR's farm in Kack Wielki, Poland during the winter of 1945/1946. VOKIETAITIS told MAZUR that he was a Pole from Lithuania.

v. LAUNICS, a Latvian and former 1st Lt. in the Latvian Legion during World War II. He participated in organizing escapes from Gdynia to Sweden, after

World War II. His alias may have been RUSSEATS.

w. Juozas ADOMAITIS @ EKRAJUNAS, a Lithuanian resistance member, who infiltrated and exfiltrated through Poland in 1947.

x. Alfonsas RIBEIKA, a Lithuanian resistance member was dispatched by DEKSNYS from Sweden to Gdynia to pick up material from a BDPS courier in 1947.

y. Jonas DAIMAUSKAS, alias Jan DAJNOSKI, a Lithuanian who emigrated from Poland to France in 1957. His wife Leokadie (Leodakija) Daimauskas nee MARKEVICUTE now resides in Chicago. DAIMAUSKAS has some contact with VOKIETAITIS.

z. OLTIN, who was to be employed as a seaman by DEKSNYS to deliver material to Poland in 1947.

aa. Rumanus SHKUKIS, a CIC officer on friendly terms with DEKSNYS in Sweden in 1948.

bb. ZASKEVICIUS, a Lithuanian resistance leader who arrived in Poland Dec. 1948 and was to meet DEKSNYS in Luebeck.

cc. Mikes PECIUNAS, a Lithuanian resistance leader in Warsaw, Poland in spring 1950. He requested help from Sweden to

dd. Antanas SAPALAS, a Lithuanian who was imprisoned in a Nazi KZ camp near Danzig, where he was in contact with VOKIETAITIS.

ee. Arseniy Leonidovich ZAVADSKI, a Russian national, who was an officer with SMERSH in Riga, Latvia after World War II. He defected in West Berlin in 1952.
