MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: ZYMANTAS-ZAKEVICIUS, Stasys
[aka: ZAKEVICKIUS, Stasys
ZAKAS, Stasys
BUTAUTAS, Stasys]

1. According to unsourced information dated 21 May 1963, Subject was a member of a People's Commissariat for Internal Affairs (NKVD) sponsored organization while at the University of Vilnius in 1941.

2. In a report dated 6 August 1963, an official British service indicated that Subject had been employed by them as an agent against the Germans during World War II and later between 1947 and 1956. This Service added that it had no record of Subject having been a member of a NKVD-sponsored organization in 1941.

3. Information dated 20 December 1949 from a refugee source of undetermined reliability indicated that Subject did not follow Lithuania's national aspirations, but through his own personal ambitions permitted himself to become an intelligence agent in the pay of foreign powers. Source indicated that these "foreign powers" probably included Sweden, England, and the United States.
