of US Government Interest in LSD-25 (Lysergic Acid)
Research.

1. Our field office representative has reported that on 5 August 1954, Subject had a conference with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The three men talked over the research on LSD 25 being conducted by Subject at the [REDACTED] indicated that he was well pleased with the work and that he would continue to supply Subject with all of the LSD-25 he might need.

2. [REDACTED] stated that the [REDACTED] has insisted that careful records be kept by the [REDACTED] in the United States regarding the use and distribution of LSD-25 in this country. [REDACTED] has further insisted that a charge of US \$1.75 per box of six ampules (100 micrograms of LSD per ampule) be made and the [REDACTED] be prepared to show a billings slip for each sale. After this discussion [REDACTED] to leave the room.

3. When they were alone, [REDACTED] told Subject in confidence, that a close friend of his had informed him that the US Government was very interested in LSD and its possible use as a chemical warfare agent and its possible use in unorthodox activities. [REDACTED] did not indicate that he knew what branch of the US Government was interested nor did he reveal the location of the friend. [REDACTED] volunteered that he had told no one but the Subject about his knowledge of US Government interest in LSD, and further, that he had not and would not tell the officials about the interest.

4. The Subject did not reveal to [REDACTED] that US Government representatives had contacted him regarding the [REDACTED] research on LSD.
