Damian, Off the record, [Redacted] will be getting back to you with our official comment. One thing I'd point you to in the meantime. You'll see on our account we've often marked special anniversaries of Intel history events with articles and tweets. We've done this with successes such as UBL, Argo and others and failures, such as the Powers shutdown, Bay of Pigs. This is standard m.o. for the account. Also the technique of tweeting historical events has been used before. I believe the Marine Corps did it for the anniversary of Iwo Jima this past February and JFK library did it for the Cuban Missile crisis in 2012. (b)(3)
