MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Interview Between Planning Staff and
Commander Richard Reeve.

1. This morning, Admiral Souers alerted the Planning Staff that Comdr. Richard Reeve would call to discuss a suggestion originating with the Dolier mission.

2. Comdr. Richard Reeve called at 3:00 P.M. and discussed the matter with Capt. Goggins, Col. Nicholas and Col. Mussett. He explained that Mr. Dolier is preparing his final summary report regarding the activities of his mission in Japan. He is prepared to include in it any pertinent observations about means of improving U. S. intelligence, and would appreciate any suggestions which the Central Intelligence Group might make.

3. Comdr. Reeve stated that Mr. Dolier will be willing to receive the suggestions in any form: i.e., they may be formal and suitable for quotation; they may be informal, not to be quoted; they may be either extensive or brief; or they may be given orally.

4. The Planning Staff told Comdr. Reeve that C.I.G. will be very glad to study the matter with a view to giving Mr. Dolier some useful statement within a week or two.

5. No further action by the Director's office is necessary at this time. The Planning Staff will initiate the project and submit appropriate recommendations for approval of the Director, C.I.G.
