

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD.


6 August 1946

General Norstad called me and said that General Marshall, in his position as Supreme American Commander in China, had decreed that all intelligence activities within the Mukden area were to be placed immediately under the supervision and coordination of the Consul General.

General Norstad said that there might be some objections from various sources - CIG or G-2 - and if any objections did arise, he would like to be informed personally of them.

I told him that I saw no immediate objections from the standpoint of CIG but realized that he would receive serious objections from G-2.

He agreed with that but asked again that if we had any objections or anything came up in that regard to inform him personally. He also said that the message from General Marshall was available for us to look at at any time we wanted to.
