OVERALL FOLICIES AND OBJECTIVES FOR THE COORDIWATION OF INTELLIGENCE HELATING TO FOREIGN INFOSTRIAL ESTABLISHENTS. This paper has been circulated for comment by voting alips to the members of the IAB and also to the Departments of the Interior and commerce and the U. S. Tariff Commission, who have been invited to sit as additional members of the IAB for consideration of this paper.

CIG 23 3 January Minutes of the 11th IAB Meeting 26 November COORDINATION OF INTRILIGENCE PRODUCTION. The IAB agreed at its 11th meeting that: a. GIO would prepare a draft of the overall policies and objectives for the coordination of the production of intelligence; and b. the above-mentioned paper would be submitted to an ad hoc committee for consideration. HOTS: As a result of the above action GIO 23 has been circulated to the IAB requesting that their ad hoc committee members advise the Secretary, NIA, as to when they would be prepared to discuss this paper.

1. I was "authorized and directed" by paragraph 3 of HIA Directive No. 5 "to ast for this Authority in coordinating all Federal foreign intelligence agencies relating to the national scourity to insure that the overall policies and objectives established by this Anthority are properly implemented and expected."

2. My interpretation of the several HIA Directives and of the discussions which have taken place at HIA meetings has been that the Anthonity degires a complete and thereagh coordination of the intelligenese activities of the four intelligence agencies of the Government (State, 6-2, 4-2, and CHI). I believe that the objectives are to insure complete coverage in the intelligence field, to eliminate duplisetion (by which I do not mean an elimination of a beneficial overlap), and to bring about integration of effort which will result in the production of "strategie and national policy intelligence" of the highest possible caliber.

3. In our attempt to implement these "policies and objectives," the Cantral Intelligence Group has held immunerable meetings with representatives of the four intelligence agencies, both at the policy and working level.

4. I regret that I now find it necessary to report to you that we are not meeting with that cooperative spirit without which, in my opinion, we cannot accomplish the President's desire "that all Federal foreign intelligence activities be planned, developed, and coordinated so as to assure the most effective accomplishment of the intelligence mission related to the national security." In the belief that this may be the result of a lack of clearly defined policy, I am preparing for submission to you through the IAB proposed specific policies and objectives which you must formally and specifically establish before further constructive progress can be made.

5. It appears that certain of the agencies are interpreting too broadly, perhaps with solfish motives and nost certainly not with constructive ideas of ecordination or economy, the Freeident's statement that "the emisting intelligence agencies of your departments will continue to collect, evaluate, correlate, and disconingte departmental intelligence."

6. I will propose that each of the four intelligence agencies have delinested for them by the Estimal Intelligence Authority their particular "departmental intelligence" and primary responsibilities, and that they be directed to discontinue those activities which are thus allocated to another agency and can best be performed, in the national interest, by that other agency on its behalf. This would not preslude the analysis by any agency of another agency's intelligence reports in the preparation of its own estimates. Nor would this prevent the collection by any agency of material not in its field since I am of the belief that all foreign representatives, whether they be from State, War or Mavy, should not only feel free, but even be urged, to keep their eyes and ears open at all times for all information affecting the national security. However, they should have specific directives telling these of those fields on which they will concentrate and the manner in which they will integrate their activities with other field representatives.

7. Those activities which the four agencies are now carrying on not in their field of primary responsibility should be transferred to the agency having primary responsibility so that the work there may be strengthened and made so complete as to most not only the operational requirements of the aganay of primary interest but the information requirements of all other agancies having a secondary interest. An integrated program for interegancy discumination of this material must be developed computerably.

8. In addition, there is an important area in the intelligence field which connot be considered as being primary to any one intelligence egongy but is of equal importance to all agencies. That, I believe, the Mational Intelligence Authority desires be contralised in 618 or otherwise allocated in the interests of econogr and efficiency. Without specific XIA directives stating that will be expected of CIO, it emant complete its organization to accept centralized regrongibilities. And it does not desire to accept any responsibility until it can render the service required. A specific proposal for controligation was first made by OHI in what is known as OIG No. 13, but when an attempt was made by representatives at an interagency mosting to arrive at a definition of mattery of comme concern and of mattery of privary interest to each agency there was so complete a disagreement that I an having to report to the next IAB mosting that so agreement could X be reached.

9. In my opinion, this aganty stitute is unliss at this time when budgetary restrictions are necessitating a retransment. With the inevitable result, that agancies having only a stoundary interest and only give the most shallow treatment to matters which could better be headled for them by the agancy having primary interest, or by the GIG is matters of scenar concern. 10. I will request of the HIA through the IAB a specific directive: (1) setting forth in some detail the areas of primery requescibility of such of the four intelligence agentice of the generators and their responsibilities to each other; (2) setting forth in equal detail these intelligence activities which one and will be controlised in the interests of economy and efficiency; (3) setting forth a detailed plan for coordination of discontantion to insure that the results of the re-allocated activities will still be available to all agencies for analysis and integration into their "departmental intelligence"; and (b) setting forth a plan for appliection should to integrate the activities of collection personnel to insure the best possible collection and reporting program.
