MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

At request of Mr. Ohly, Special Assistant to the Secretary of Defense, interviewed [redacted]

[redacted] is an ex-Lieutenant USAAF, who was relieved from active duty prior to V-J Day due to "combat fatigue". He is one of a group (he stated) being considered by the [redacted]. He realizes such [redacted]. But he feels it his duty to arrange for a channel through which he might transmit to the proper U. S. authorities any information of intelligence value he might obtain in the event he goes [redacted].

I suggested he drop in to see me on his return from New York in the next few days. In the meantime I have requested Exec for I & S to make a spot check of the subject.
