MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD:

This morning I had breakfast with Mr. Allen Dulles at his home, 239 East 61st Street, New York. We discussed conditions in general and I obtained his reactions to two specific points of interest, as follows:

1. He understands our reluctance to have too many individuals involved in the inspection of OSO. He will talk it over with Jackson and Correa and see if it can't be held to an inspection by him (Dulles) with the assistance of SO personnel known to him. It is obvious that he would prefer the assistance of Dick Helms.

At the outset of our conversation, Mr. Dulles told me that he had talked with Stuart Menzies and Easton and had explained, in a general way, his connection with us. He said they both indicated complete satisfaction with our connections with them, with CIA as an Agency,
