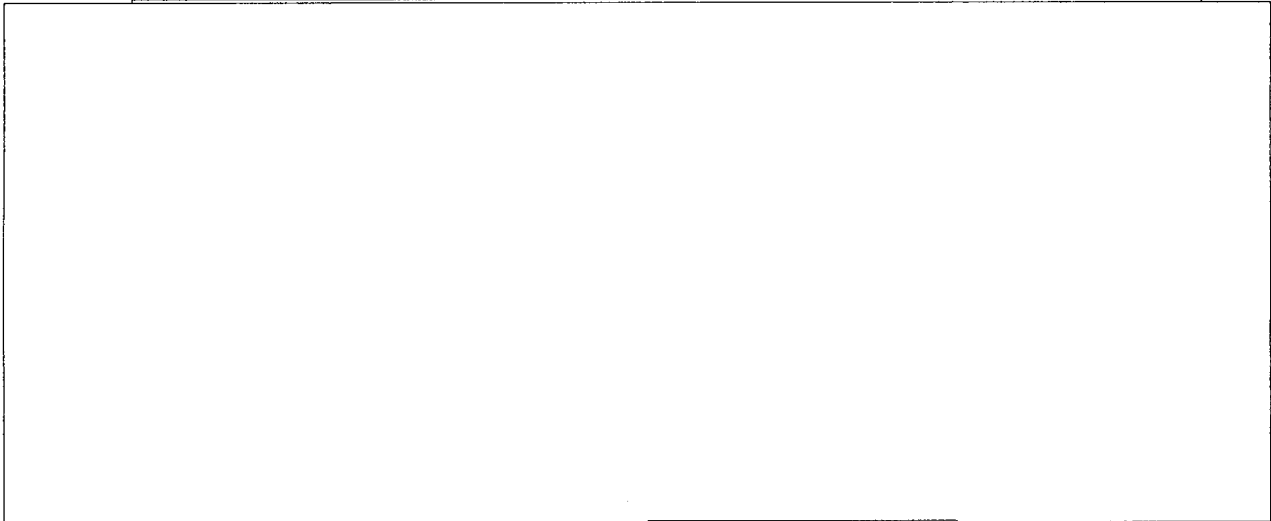

Deputy Director lectured at the National War College on "CIA and its Mission".

Remained to lunch with General Lemnitzer and staff officers.

Mr. Cassady queried concerning any details of Project X as reported in the Daily News, 25 March. No additional information was obtainable through normal channels with the Capitol.

Requested Mr. Helms, OSO, to obtain background information on Constantine Barsky and to have interrogator talk with the Deputy Director on 26 March for details in connection with the Saturday morning conference with Barsky.

Mr. Sidney Shallett, columnist, writing an article for Saturday Evening Post on General Vandenberg. Requested appointment with the Deputy Director for information on subject -- Monday 0930.

Called [redacted] applicant (New Mexico Publishing Company, 202 Marcy St., Sante Fe, New Mexico-- phone 3000, relative possible employment. Subject indicated definite interest--particularly in job which would combine editorial with research and analysis. Expressed satisfaction with probable offer of P-5. Mr. Cassady will give him further details in letter. Applicant stated he would prefer to give employer 30 days notice; in lieu thereof a letter from CIA to his employer would suffice.

Mr. Franklin Porter, USES, reference "occupational analyst"--referred to Personnel Br.

Mr. Houston and Deputy Director called on Mr. John Davies, State, in connection with "excise".
