The Commanding General, VIII Corps, reported transportation difficulties due to energy bombing, the move of Chinese "Volunteer Army" units on 19 January, and failure of the Chinese to provide trains as planned. Advance reconnaissance by Comments the Commanding General of VIII Corps on 23 January indicated that the VIII Corps had planned to locate in the Wonsan area; howpvor, the area was already crowded with other Korean and Chinese units. At least some VIII Corps units will probably perform defense missions along the east coast. Other messages have indicated that by 4 February the North Korean VI, VII and VIII Corps had re-cbived their allotments of artillery prime movers and that on 25 January the VII Corps also began to move from Manchuria.
