The Director stated that he still was not satisfied with the Intelligence Bulletin and that he wanted more material such as that which [redacted] included in his Daily Digest included in the Daily Bulletin. He also stated that he would like to have certain items of intelligence information that resulted from CIA operations included in the Daily Bulletin.

The Director suggested that [redacted] be asked to come to Washington to discuss a job in O/CI, O/PC and Psychological Warfare.

The Director approved the establishment of a conference room in the Administration Building for the covert offices to use in dealing with foreign intelligence services.

It was reported that the House Committee on Un-American Affairs had asked for the Personal History Statement of [redacted]. [redacted] The Director approved its release to them if there was no security threat.
