Mr. Reber reported that three items would be considered in the IAC meeting: General Bolling's suggestion for an estimate on Yugoslavia; German re-militarization; and an IAC progress report.

Mr. O'Gara reported that an advisory committee on training had been established and that he had been requested to meet with Mr. Scott of State on an undisclosed subject.

There was discussion of liaison with the State Department on administrative matters and the control of letters such as that from Assistant Secretary Thorpe to [redacted] on East-West trade.

Mr. [redacted] said that he was to meet with General Hershey on the agency draft policy and that the agency draft regulation would be issued shortly.
