Daily Staff Meeting

Wednesday, 23 May 1951

It was reported that the Director had addressed the Overseas Press Club in a "for background only" speech and had answered questions off the record.

The proceedings of the Inter-Agency Defector Committee were reported.

Mr. Reber reported that the psychological warriors had agreed on the set-up and agenda for the Psychological Strategy Board.

[redacted] reported that the delay in presenting O/PC requirements to G-4 might seriously interfere with our getting the material that we needed. Mr. Kirkpatrick said that he had authorized this delay in view of the magnitude paper and because he had been told that requirements are being presented to G-4 on an ad hoc daily basis. It was agreed that steps would be taken to see what could be done to speed up the presentation of requirements.
