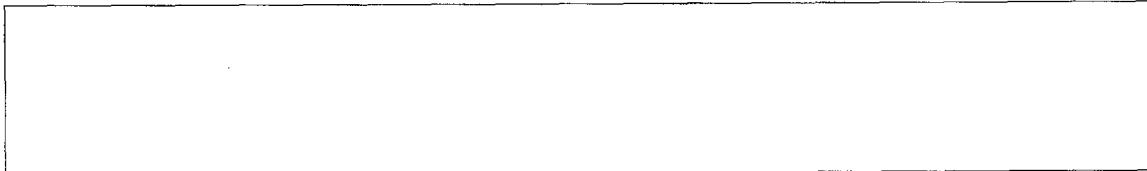
The Director requested that the Duty Officer in O/CI be instructed to forward his mail to this office without opening it.

Mr. Dulles raised the question of the invitation to send a representative to a sub-committee of the IIC. After discussion it was generally agreed that the O/SO representatives who are FBI alumni should not go and that perhaps Mr. Kirkpatrick should attend.

It was reported that O/SO had been instructed to have somebody thank [redacted] orally for his citation and that nothing would be put in writing.



There was discussion of sending a Daily Intelligence Summary to General Eisenhower. Mr. Kirkpatrick is to work out the details so that [redacted] can complete the arrangements upon his return.



Mr. Dulles called attention to the FBI's dissemination of foreign intelligence on the Soviet war plans.
