□ Mr. Wolf reported that [Redacted] would report on 16 July for a short period and then be away until Labor Day at which time he would report permanently. He is bringing with him a man named Briggs to be his assistant.

The Director asked whether [Redacted] was to be hired. It was pointed out that this wouldn't be done until the contract had been signed and that certain unanticipated difficulties had risen in this connection.

Mr. Kirkpatrick reported that General Truscott had advocated including East German Scientists in the defector center and expressed the opinion that they could handle them.

It was recommended that the Psychological Strategy Board be convened for a meeting at an early date inasmuch as a month has lapsed since the last meeting.

The Director said that Mr. Kirkpatrick and Mr. Wolf should call on Mrs. Rosenberg at her convenience to discuss the matter of military personnel.
