Director's Meeting

Wednesday, 20 June 1951

Mr. Jackson reported that the Committee for Free Europe had asked Dr. Langer to investigate their research and analysis work. He said that Langer couldn't be spared and he planned to send [redacted]

Mr. Jackson reported that a [redacted] who had worked for Pace and Alexander on scientific research and development but had difficulties with the military was available. The Director said that he believed it unwise to take on anyone who had left the Pentagon because of such difficulties.

There was discussion of procurement of material and the Director recommended [redacted] to Mr. Wolf for either fiscal or procurement matters.

Mr. Jackson reported that he found the Southeast European Division in O/SO to be one of the best that he has screened so far.

Mr. Wolf reported that [redacted] papers had been arranged and that he would be a consultant to the agency until the academic year starts.

It was reported that there was a considerable delay in transmission of material from AFSA to O/CI. Mr. Wolf stated that a report had been prepared by the Advisor for Management on this subject.
