Wednesday, 25 July 1951

Loyalty Board Meeting in the morning.

Talked to Montague about Navy comments on Annex 6. They do not seem very important.

Talked to Mr. Carey about proposed NSCID in regard to FDD. He would like this brought up at the next AD's Meeting on Monday, and I have given a copy to Mr. Jackson to read.

Called Mr. Douglass about material that we should send to General Eisenhower. He has copies of all material sent by G-2 and will prepare a summary of his conversations with General Bolling for discussion with the DCI tomorrow.

Arranged with Mr. Kirkpatrick to send a daily "highlight" cable [redacted] which he can transmit to [redacted]. Kirkpatrick will warn [redacted] that this represents raw intelligence and should be treated as such.

Talked to [redacted] about proposed changes in the OCI weekly summary. The new summary, in the dry-run stage, seems to me to be too much limited to political and economic reporting. Told [redacted] that I thought Mr. Douglass should discuss the new weekly with the DCI prior to producing it.
