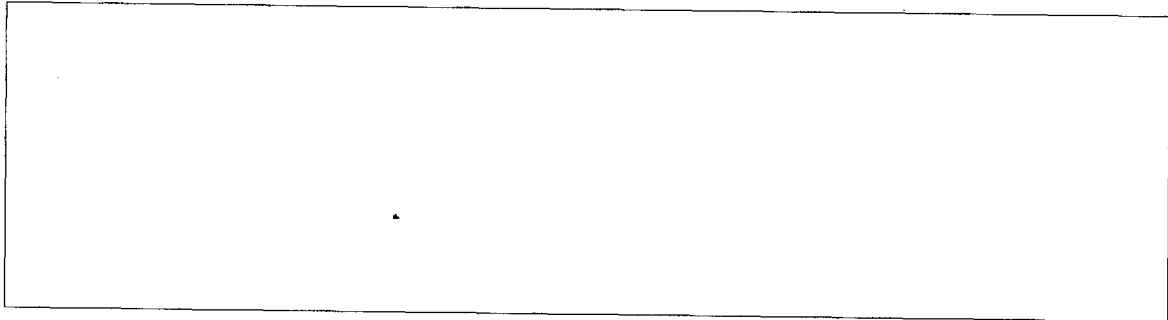

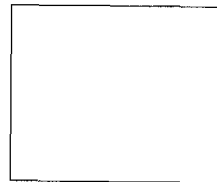

Mr. Becker and Mr. Reber discussed the desirability of designating an individual in the office of DD/P to serve as a link between Mr. Gordon Gray and DCI. Mr. Reber feels that it will be to our advantage to bring in Mr. Gray's office on all estimates and policy matters having a psychological aspect and points out that we now have the opportunity, at least in the psychological field, to bring about the desired coordination between intelligence and planning.

Mr. Reber inquired if it were necessary to publish written orders designating  as Chairman of IPC and AD/IC as the point of contact for inter-Agency IPC matters. It was the consensus of opinion that it would not be necessary to publish anything on this, but that it would be sufficient if General Smith would announce this at the next AD's meeting.
