Mr. Dulles reported that there would be an NSC Senior Staff meeting this afternoon in regard to the JCS comments on the paper. Mr. Jackson and Mr. Wisner will attend this. Mr. Jackson believes that the next move is up to the Defense Department and that Defense and JCS must sort themselves out. DCI remarked that one of the first considerations should be to see if we can get rid of any of our commitments. Mr. Jackson doubts it and feels that it would be a good lever.
