Saturday, 29 September 1951

Spoke to [] in regard to the Rangers. He believes that orders went out last night in regard to deactivation for implementation next week. [] suggested that [] call General Bradford at Fort Monroe, discuss the matter and possibly get a CIA man down to Benning Monday morning. He feels that we do not want to be accused of proselyting but that we must act quickly. Finally located [] asked him to call General Bradford and if any policy matters were involved to call Mr. Dulles first.

Talked to [] at some length about the more recent and confirming [] information. Called Mr. Dulles. With his o.k. tried to get Admiral Souers or Admiral Dennison, neither of whom were available on Saturday.
