Mr. Dulles reported that NCFA needs a new President. A San Francisco newspaper man named Smith has been suggested. Things are not going well out there and Mr. Dulles will submit recommendations for the DCI.

Mr. Dulles reported that Mr. Laughton and Mr. Statts of the Bureau of Budget would be here at 4:30 this afternoon for conversation with the DCI, D/DCI, and AD/RR.

Colonel Taylor brought up the question of briefing General Cabell's successor. The DCI states that General Cabell would bring him in in the near future. The DCI mentioned that General McNarey would be working for Mr. Harriman in the future. He may want a briefing on Soviet capabilities along the line of SE 16. Mr. Larocque will check with Mr. Kent and suggest that he do the briefing and call Colonel Beebe in Mr. Nash's office.
