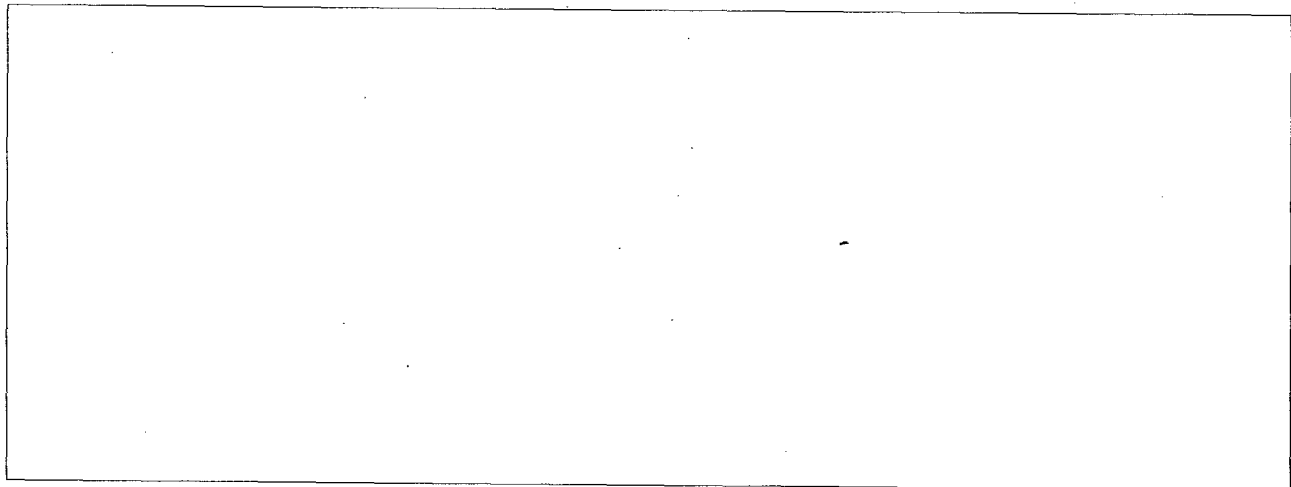
Spoke to Dr. Langer prior to the IAC meeting and suggested, with respect to [redacted] request for a revised estimate on Indochina, that such revision should cover all of Southeast Asia since an entirely new situation would exist if negotiations were successful. Dr. Langer agreed.

Consulted with Messrs. Douglass and Clark respecting a letter of instructions to the Brownell Committee and after I had made some revisions consistent with their suggestions they approved. Communicated with [redacted] office and alerted them that I would like to bring over the revised letter as soon as possible.

Authorized [redacted] to attend the IAC.

Discussed with Dr. Chadwell the procedure on consultants for an AE estimate.



Suggested to Bob Taylor that he request Hulick to keep a diary covering the activities of DD/P's staff which are not of sufficient importance to be included in the Log but which should be known in this office. I made it plain that this was not intended as a substitution for their attendance at the morning meeting, but would probably save everybody time.
