Raised the question of sending a message to our field stations regarding the appointment of (1) the Director as Under Secretary of State; (2) the Jackson Committee to investigate cold war activities. After some discussion, D/DCI undertook to draft such a message for the approval of the Director.

b. Suggested that he and Sheff Edwards prepare a chronological report on the [Redacted] affair. Mr. Hedden noted that he was presently preparing such a report at the Director's request. DD/P undertook to furnish Mr. Hedden with the material he had on hand concerning this matter.
