PARAGRAPH SIX TO TDCSDB-3,631,293 SHOULD BE CHANGED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

6. IN THE EVENT THAT THE WESTERN POWERS SHOULD SUDDENLY UNLEASH A WAR, THE GSGF MUST HOLD OUT FOR FOUR - SIX HOURS, BECAUSE THAT IS THE PERIOD DURING WHICH THE SECOND ECHELON OF SOVIET TROOPS WILL MOVE UP, EQUIPPED WITH ALL TYPES OF MODERN WEAPONS. THE SECOND ECHELON WILL HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR OFFENSIVE ACTION, AND THE EXPERIENCE GAINED IN MOVING TROOPS INTO HUNGARY INDICATES THAT IT WILL REQUIRE FOUR - SIX HOURS TO DEPLOY THE SECOND ECHELON.
