PARAGRAPH 2: ZHUKOV STATED THAT THE OFFICERS AND ENLISTED MEN OF THE INDIAN AND
BURMESE ARMIES ARE, NEVERTHELESS, IN A GOOD STATE OF PHYSICAL FITNESS.

PARAGRAPHS 5 THROUGH 7: ZHUKOV STATED THAT ATOMIC WEAPONS WILL DEFINITELY BE
USED, BECAUSE ALL [SOVIET] TACTICAL CONCEPTS AND OPERATIONAL PLANNING ARE BASED
UPON CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH ATOMIC WEAPONS WILL BE EMPLOYED, AND THAT IT IS
INCONCEIVABLE THAT ATOMIC WEAPONS WOULD NOT BE USED, REGARDLESS OF TALKS CONCERNING
THE PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF ATOMIC WEAPONS.

PARAGRAPH 6: THE WORD "DEPLOY" IN THE LAST SENTENCE SHOULD BE CHANGED TO
"CONCENTRATE".
