1. The Republic of Indonesia, although having no diplomatic relations with China, joined the International Civil Aviation Organization on April 27, 1950 and, like this Government, is bound by the ICAO principle of reciprocity applicable to all member States. Regretably, since October last, our requests for charter flights to make technical landings at Djakarta and Makassar have either been turned down or given no reply by the Indonesia civil aviation authority. Details are:
 - (1) On 31 October 1955, we wired our request for landing clearance at Djakarta for B-854 and B-856 (Martha Graham charter) at beginning of December for a 7-day stopover prior to proceeding to Singapore, and followed up with cables sent on November 10 and 23. The Indonesian civil aviation authority gave no reply.
 - (2) On 28 October 1956, we wired our request for technical landing (refuelling) clearance at Makassar for B-1002 scheduled to carry our delegation to the Olympics from Taipei to Australia. The Indonesian civil aviation authority turned down the request without justifiable reason.
 - (3) Recently, we applied, through KIM, Djakarta landing clearance for a KLM engine charter flight, Bangkok/Djakarta/Bangkok. No favorable result was obtained.
2. Enclosed please find a complete set of copies of pertinent cables for your reference. It is respectfully requested that the matter be brought up with the authorities concerned.
