1. As you are aware, DPD is concerning itself with providing for the contingency of close air support to Laos in the event Communist aggression moves to a showdown in that arena. The DCI, with BOB concurrence, has approved an allocation of [] from the Contingency Reserve for the first phase of [] which calls for preparation of four B-26 aircraft to combat readiness at [] Tainan. DPD is administering these funds. At the moment, informal estimates from [] place the cost of rehabilitation of these aircraft at approximately [] though this amount is subject to change.

2. []
[] You will recall that these same aircraft were involved in the [] operation, at which time they were "sold" to a Mr. [] in [] for [] and he in turn "sold" them to [] ownership trail ends. We have given them a new series of numbers and a new lease on life with the proposed rehabilitation.

3. The subject contract, copy attached, is then submitted to you for your review as to its form and apparent substance, with a request that you approve it or suggest modifications to make it viable. I might

also ask you if you think it is in shape at present so that an additional requirement could be included in it; namely, that of providing for helicopter training of ten pilots, not contemplated at the time the instant draft was created.
