SUBJECT

: Seviet Surface-te-Surface Missile Deployment (USIS-D-33.4/19)

- 1. Subject paper contains the results of the latest re-examination by OMAIC and its Deployment Working Group of all evidence concerning IGBM and MRBM deployment. It is pointed out that there are few ICBM site-complexes but a relatively large number of MRBM site-complexes in the "confirmed" to "possible" categories. These are included in Tables 1 and 2, as well as status of construction.
- 2. It is noted that some of the intelligence agencies concerned differ on the assessment of several sites, but there are no footnetes; subject paper averages the differences. In particular, the Air Force has more "probable" and "possible" ICBM sites than are indicated in this report. I believe that this paper is a long step toward getting agreement in the quantitative missile estimates.
