MEMORANDUM FOR GENERAL NORSTAD

SUBJECT: "JACK PINE" Plans (U)

- 1. The Ambassadorial Group in Washington has been considering possible actions the "GDR" or USSR may take in attempting to deny air access to Berlin. Possible counter-actions available to the Allied powers have also been discussed.
- 2. It is requested that you study urgently and make recommendations relative to expanding JACK PINE plans to include graduated counter-action against enemy airfields, AAA and missile sites, and ground installations. It would be understood that any such counter-action would be the subject of a separate political decision to be taken at the time.
