PREFACE

This report is one in a series on Soviet Ground Force and Logistic installations being prepared for a DIA/CIA Panel. The series is being coordinated, published and disseminated by NPIC. The photographic analysis is being performed by the NPIC Photographic Analysis Group, the CIA Photographic Intelligence Division (NPIC), and the Production Center 1P1c (DIA). The photographic analysis for this particular report was performed by the Production Center 1P1c.

In the interest of uniformity, the titles and letter designators for the facilities observed at these installations are identical with those appearing in the project requirement. When a specific facility is not observed both its title and letter designator are omitted in the report.

Titles and letter designators for the various facilities are as follows: (A) railroad service, (B) road service, (C) landing strips, (D) administrative and troop housing areas, (E) storage areas, (F) ammunition storage areas, (G) POL storage areas, (H) other buildings and facilities, (J) equipment storage/maintenance areas, (K) athletic fields, (L) small arms firing ranges, (M) driver training areas, (N) tank/ assault gun firing ranges, (P) flat trajectory firing ranges, (Q) artillery emplacements (batteries), (R) infantry or combined arms field training areas or courses, (S) special training facilities, (T) unidentified facilities or tracking activity.




FIGURE 1. LOCATION OF CHERNOVTSY ARMY BARRACKS ROSHTSHINSKAYA.

SUMMARY

This 35-acre military installation is located in the northwest section of the city of Chernovtsy (Figure 1). The installation is served by hard-surface urban streets. The Chernovtsy-Kolomyya railroad serves the city and is also accessible to the military installation.

The installation (Figures 2 and 3) is secured by a fence, and can house approximately 1,800 troops. It contains three probable multistory barracks, one probable multistory administration building/barracks, two probable vehicle maintenance/storage buildings, two probable storage buildings, and five probable support buildings.

The nearest training and maneuver area is near Storozhinets, approximately 28 kilometers (km) southwest of the installation.

The installation is covered by TALENT photography of 1956 and KEYHOLE photography between September 1961 and June 1964. Comparison reveals no significant changes from 1956 to 1964.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Railroad Service

The city of Chernovtsy is served by the northwest-southeastChernovtsy-Kolomyyarailroad. One classification year was observed within the city. No repair facilities were noted.

Road Service

Several hard surface roads in and around the installation lead to the city of Chernovtsy.

Aircraft Landing Strips

Two km southeast of the city is a sod strip with a landing area 6,200 by 2,900 feet.

Chernovtsy Northwest Airfield, with a 6,600 by 200-foot concrete runway is located 16 km northwest of the city.


Administrative and Troop Housing Areas

The installation contains three probable multistory barracks with a capacity of approximately 1,800 troops, one probable multistory administration building/barracks, two 300- by 40-foot probable vehicle maintenance storage buildings, five probable support buildings, and two probable storage buildings.






