**MOC WILL PERMIT CAL TO INAUGURATE  
INTERNATIONAL AIR ROUTES**

(UNN): The Ministry of Communications is considering to grant permission to China Airlines to inaugurate international air routes, based on an evaluation of international air transport needs.

CAL originally operated 12 weekly flights between Taipei and Hongkong and has recently cancelled its two Wednesday and Friday afternoon flights because of scheduling difficulties. In order to meet this air transport need, consideration to call in CAL is being given by MOC in view of CAL's fine performance in its earlier operations to Hongkong, Seoul, Saigon and Kuala Lumpur in recent years.

CAL will immediately purchase new type aircraft(s) from abroad as soon as permission to inaugurate international routes is granted by MOC, it is learned.
