## SUMMARY

A military training area is located along the northern side of the Severnyy Doncts River, 10 kilometces (km) north of Slavyanoscrbsk and 10 km southwest of Bakhmutovka (ligurel).

This installation covers approximately 12,800 acres and contains 6 administration buildings, 32 barracks/quartcrs, 17 support building 6 vehicle sheds, a probable vehicle maintenance building, and 5 unidentificd buildings, one of which is secured (ligure 2).

Graining facililies include an athlecic field, 2 small-arms firing ranges, 2 uracked-vehicle driver-training courses, 4 tank/assault-gun
firing ranges with 8 suphort buildings, a bined-arms field raining area, and 2 pre vehicle-mounted automitic-weapons i ranges.

The area was coverod on 4 Kl X missions between April 1462 and July Significant changes include the addition tracked-vehicle driver-tr ining course be April and November of 1961 and a assault-gun firing rang, berween Nove 1962 and June 1964. Th. area appoars: on all photography.

## Road Service

Secondary roads provide access to Lugansk and nearby villages.
Administration and Troop 1 lousing Nrea
Area 1) contans 6 administration buildings, 32 barracks/quarters, and 12 support buildings. This is a bivouac area providing billeting, administration and other support for the training area.

## Other Buildings and liacilities

Area lil contains 4 unidentified buildings.
Area 112 contains 1 unidentified secured building.

Area $J$ contains 6 vehicle sheds (each 265 by 40 feet), 1 probable velicle maintenance building ( 80 by 60 feet), and 5 support buildings.

Area $\mathrm{N}^{2}$ is a 4,330-ioot range with 3 lanes (cach 2,350 feet lontr), 2 moving runs, and 2 support buildings. lhis

Area N3 is a 4,330- toot range with 4 firing lancs (each 2,400 feet long), 2 moving larget runs, and 2. suppori buildings. lhis range appears active.

Area N4 is a 3,000 -foot range with 4 moving larget runs, and one support building. this range appears active.

Combined-Arms Picld Training Area
Area $k$ concains linear vehicle irackage with trenching at right angles ro the tracks.

Special Training tacilities
Area $S L$ is a probable vehicle mounced automatic-weapons firing range and contains $\cdot 2$ moving-target runs and a short drining arca with turning loops on both ends parallel to the target, Light activily was observed.

Arca 52 is a probable vehicle-mounted atomatic-wcapons firing range and contains i) moving-targel runs and 3 closed-circuit driving courses parallel to the latges. Other probable vehicle racks inticate addi ional approaches to the targets from the west.
