

PREFACE



SUMMARY

A barracks area is located in the northeast section of Smolensk (Figure 1).




FIGURE 3. BARRACKS AREA. Sketch compiled from

The area covers approximately 20 acres and contains a secured administration building, 17 small barracks, 5 probable quarters, 2 storage buildings, and 4 support buildings (Figures 2 and 3).

The area was covered on TALENT photog-

raphy of July 1956 and on 5 KEYHOLE missions between April 1962 and October 1964. One barracks and 2 support buildings were added between July 1956 and April 1962, and the administration building was extended between April 1962 and June 1964. The installation appears active and occupied.

DESCRIPTION OF INSTALLATION

Road Service

The installation is served by city streets.

Administration and Troop Housing Area

Area D contains a U-shaped administration building which is separately secured, 17 small barracks, 5 probable quarters, 2 storage buildings, and 4 support buildings. One barracks and 2 support buildings were added be-

tween July 1956 and April 1962, and both wings of the U-shaped administration building were extended between April 1962 and June 1964.

POL Storage Area

Smolensk Petroleum Storage No 1 at 54-48N 032-05E contains 1 large, 6 medium, and 4 small POL tanks.
