**PENGHU COUNCILMEN URGE CONTINUATION
OF CAT SERVICES**

The Penghu councilmen met yesterday (October 19) afternoon on the rumored discontinuation of CAT domestic services and unanimously resolved that any such discontinuation be called off in the interest of local economic well-being, taxation and tourism.

The councilmen not only urged CAT to continue serving the military and civilians on Penghu but expressed a welcome to Far Eastern Air Transport Corporation and Taiwan Aviation Corporation to operate to Makung to relieve traffic congestion.

The resolution reached will be forwarded to the Ministry of Communications, Civil Aeronautics Administration, Taiwan Provincial Government, Taiwan Provincial Assembly and Civil Air Transport, it was learned.
