1. PANAM AND AIR AMERICA REMAIN ON STRIKE. LABOR MINISTRY CONCILIATOR REPORTS THAT <u>NEGOTIATIONS</u> IN BOTH INSTANCES <u>HAVE BEEN ACERBATED BY MANAGEMENT INSISTENCE ON FIRING STRIKE</u> <u>LEADERS</u>. NEXT NEGOTIATION ON PANAM STRIKE WILL NOT BE HELD TILL DEC. 29, AND IN MEANTIME PANAM IS REPLACING STRIKERS NOT ONLY WITH MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL BUT ALSO (OVER VIGOROUS UNION PROTESTS) WITH AMERICAN MILITARY PERSONNEL.

PAGE 2 RUMJIR 14190 C O N F I D E N T I A L IS SCHEDULED AT LABOR MINISTRY ON MORNING OF DEC. 26. DECI-SION ON WHETHER TO WALK OUT WILL NOT BE MADE BEFORE THEN, CVT LEADERS SAY. CEE MANAGEMENT SOURCES SAY STRIKE IS A DISTINCT POSSIBILITY, SINCE CEE IMPLEMENTATION OF A COMMITMENT FOR A 13TH MONTH BONUS DEPENDS ON OUTCOME OF CEE NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE GVN OVER SALE OF THE FRENCH COMPANY'S PROPERTY, WHICH ARE NOT YET CONCLUDED.

4. LABOR MINISTER PHO BA LONG EXPLAINS FLURRY OF STRIKE ACTIVITY AS <u>CAUSED BY INTERNAL UNION POLITICS</u>, SAIGON CVT COUNCIL SECRETARY VO VAN TAI, LONG BELIEVES, WANTS TO STRENGTHEN HIS OWN POSITION DURING THE ABSENCE IN EUROPE OF CVT PRESIDENT TRAN QUOC BUU, WITH WHOM TAI HAS BEEN AT ODDS.

5. CVT SOURCES NOT PARTICULARLY FRIENDLY WITH TAI POOH-POOH THIS EXPLANATION, AND SAY THAT THE STRIKES AND STRIKE THREATS ARE BASED ON PERFECTLY NORMAL TRADE UNION ISSUES. SPECIAL CONCERN THAT THE NEXT CONCILIATION SESSION WITH PANAM MANAGEMENT WILL NOT BE UNTIL DEC. 29. WE SHARE THIS CONCERN. WE WILL TALK WITH LABOR MINISTER, AND IF HE AGREES, WE WILL INFORMALLY ENCOURAGE SOME KIND OF EARLIER MEETING BETWEEN PANAM AND KEY UNION LEADERS.
