- 4. According to an Israeli radio report, Israeli naval vessels staged a raid during the night on the Egyptian port of Ras Gharib in the southern Gulf of Suez and burned Egyptian vessels and ammunition supplies. The Israeli report claimed that the base was a staging area for Egyptian commandos. The raid reflects Israeli sensitivity to threats of Egyptian landings in the southern Sinai peninsula.
- 5. According to recently available information, Egyptian naval units in the Mediterranean, assisted by four helicoptors, yesterday afternoon expended ordnance on what may have been a submarine. Neither the identity of the target nor results of the attack were reported.

SYRIAN FRONT

- 6. There was no reported ground force activity during the night. In the air the Israelis conducted extensive operations throughout the night, and have attacked Damascus this morning. Israeli aircraft have penetrated Lebanon as far north as Beirut and east to Boalbek. A report of Israeli and unidentified aircraft ranging over northern Lebanon and the Mediterranean sea suggests that an air battle may be in progress.
- 7. Radio Damascus reports that in addition to bombing Damascus, Israeli aircraft have attacked the ports of Tartus and Latakia. The Syrians also report that ground fighting has broken out in the northern sector of the front. Israel claims to have repulsed a small Syrian-Iraqi counterattack in the vicinity of Sasa.

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EGYPTIAN OBJECTIVES

17. The Egyptian army attache in Islamabad told his US counterpart yesterday that Egypt's only objective in the current war is to regain territory lost in 1967. Egypt has no designs on Israeli territory, according to the attache. Within six months of a peace settlement, Egyptian labor and American engineers could reopen the Suez Canal. The canal would then be open to all world commerce regardless of political considerations. The attache said that Egypt was still interested in US participation in the SUMED pipeline project.

ISRAEL: THE COST OF WAR

18. Israel today announced its casualty figures for the first eight days of fighting, reporting 656 soldiers killed-compared to 777 killed during the 1967 Six-Day War-and 2,000 wounded. Among those killed in action was Major General Avrem Mendler, deputy commander of the Sinai Armored Corps.
