THE MILITARY SITUATION

(All times cited in military paragraphs are Cairo/Tel Aviv time, unless otherwise specified.)

1. An unusual lull in air activity began early in the afternoon yesterday. For a period of over twelve hours, no air activity by either side was noted on the Egyptian and Syrian fronts. Israeli aircraft were active near Suez and Al Qantarah this morning, however. Israeli planes also conducted reconnaissance flights along most of the Egyptian front. Egyptian fighters conducted patrols near Al Birijat, Tanta, and Al Mansurah airfield.

4. Israeli aircraft conducted reconnaissance flights over the Syrian side of the 1967 cease-fire line and over Lebanon this morning. 
