3 - Reports from Members of the Executive Committee:

(a) <u>SALE OF AIR ASIA</u> - The Chief Executive Officer reported that the sale of Air Asia shares to E-Systems, Inc. had been accomplished on January 31, 1975 and that approval of the outward remittance of the purchase price by the Chinese Government authorities was being processed without any known problems.

(b) <u>STAFFING PROBLEMS</u> - The Chief Executive Officer discussed generally the problems involved in the phasedown of the Company's operations with respect to the maintenance of a skilled work force. He stated that the burden of attrition and the inability of the Company to offer any career opportunities had left the roster "thin" in many areas, such as competent fiscal personnel in middle management. He posed the possibility of seeking assistance from such firms as Coopers & Lybrand on an "employee loan" basis.

(c) <u>AIR ASIA COMMERCIAL RECEIVABLES</u> - The Chief Executive Officer reported substantial progress in the collection of Air Asia commercial (non-U.S. Government) receivables, which with the exception

of six Taiwan accounts are not being transferred to E-Systems as part of the sale of Air Asia shares. In particular, he noted that the Air Vietnam account had been reduced to about \$30,000, all of it current (less than 30 days).

(d) <u>CLAIMS</u> - The Chief Executive Officer reported that claims of approximately \$2,125,000 are being pursued against Contract -0002 and that negotiations are still going forward on Contract -777 for payment of approximately \$290,000.

There being no further business to come before the Meeting, it was, on motion duly made and seconded, adjourned.
