1. Although precise information on positioning and flight status of all aircraft is not available in the Air America Washington office.

has pieced together an overall picture of the AAM fleet as of 16 April.

a. PC-6 Porters

Due to the short range (400 mi.), limited carrying capacity and need for landing strip, these aircraft are not useful for evacuation and every effort is being made to get them out of Vietnam. The current status is:

7 aircraft: crated and ready for sea shipment to

CONUS on 23 April;

8 aircraft: engines removed and shipped to Tainan.

Hulls will be shipped out if time and

space permit;

2 aircraft: under contract to U. S. Mission

1 aircraft; not certifiable as airworthy, to be left

in Vietnam.
